Earl Creps is the Co-Pastor/Founder of 360church, an Assemblies of God congregation in Berkeley, California.

Traveling widely to study congregations connecting with contemporary culture, his background also includes pastoral leadership of three churches (one Boomer, one Builder, and one Gen X), serving as the Assemblies of God national Adult Ministries Consultant, and teaching on emerging culture, leadership, and preaching/communication as a Professor at the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary, in addition to serving as their Director of Doctoral Studies.

Earl has earned an M.A. and Ph.D. in Communication Studies (Northwestern University) and a Doctor of Ministry (AGTS) degree. He also serves on the Discovery and Development team for the AoG Church Multiplication Network, deploying undergraduate students to church planting teams and training church planters.
